NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT  
PERIOD OPEN FOR CHANGE OF ONE  
ELIGIBLE CDBG ACTIVITY TO ANOTHER

The Village of Justice is requesting a change in the use of CDBG funds from one eligible project to another. NOTICE is hereby given that the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Justice are requesting citizen input on the proposed change of the use of 2006 CDBG project 06-029 funds awarded in the amount of \$50,000 for the installation of sidewalks along the East side of 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from 81<sup>st</sup> Street to 83<sup>rd</sup> Street, to complete renovation of the Thomas Street Detention Pond. The notice to proceed for the sidewalk project was received on June 4, 2007. The Village Engineer has determined that in order to maintain a 4% grade for ADA compliance, additional earth removal and a retaining wall for elaborate erosion control would need to be installed. These requirements will be extremely cost prohibitive in order for the Village to complete the sidewalk project.

The Village of Justice has made a preliminary request to Cook County to move \$50,000 in grant funds from project 06-029 to a new project in 2008 to complete the renovation of the Thomas Street Detention Pond in order to help alleviate flooding within the area. The preliminary request has tentatively been approved subject to a formal request for project change being submitted for the 2008 project year. The Village will formally apply for the change with our application in February, 2008.

The area of the Village where allocations of CDBG funds are available is bounded by 79<sup>th</sup> Street on the North, 82<sup>nd</sup> Court on the West, 85<sup>th</sup> Place on the South, and Roberts Road on the East. CDBG projects improve aging and inadequate infrastructure to support low and moderate income residential areas, to enhance community appearance and improve the health and safety of residents, and include such projects as:

1. Reconstruction, replacement and installation of street and alley pavement, curbs, gutters, catch basins, and other related components.

2. Reconstruction, replacement, and installation of sanitary sewers, storm sewers and water mains.
3. Reconstruction and installation of sidewalks, curb cuts, and ADA improvements.
4. Replacement and installation of street and alley lighting.

Written comments concerning the change in eligible projects may be sent or delivered to the Village Clerk of the Village of Justice at the Municipal Building, 7800 S. Archer Road, Justice, Illinois 60458, during the 30 day public comment period from January 17, 2008 through February 15, 2008. Notice is further given that a copy of the final applications will be available for public inspection prior to submission.
