

The Justice Police Department is currently investigating several burglaries from motor vehicles that occurred the week of June 10th at Resurrection Cemetery. The crimes occur when the victim's leave their vehicle to visit grave sites in the cemetery. During the first incident the offender(s) smashed out a window of the victim's vehicle and removed her purse and personal belongings. During the second incident the offender(s) removed two purses from a vehicle, which was left unlocked and unattended, while the victim's visited a grave site. Justice Police Detectives are currently following several leads in the above incidents and have three suspects. Residents are advised to be on the look out for the suspects in the cemetery: Suspect #1 is described as a male, white subject, approximately 5'7", 145lbs., with brown hair and brown eyes, in his early twenties. Suspect #2 is described as a female, white subject, approximately 5'2", 140lbs., with brown eyes wearing a wig, in her late forties. Suspect #3 is described as a male, black subject, approximately 6'0" 150lbs., with brown hair and brown eyes, in his early fifties. Residents are advised to contact the Justice Police immediately if these subjects are seen in the cemetery. Residents are also advised to lock their vehicle doors, keep their windows rolled up, and their personal belongings locked in their trunk while visiting graves in the cemetery.
